HERTZ TRIALGP WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP SAN MARINO





The **fourth round** of the Hertz FIM Trial World Championship was held in **San Marino** over the weekend that has just ended, on a very special race course completely situated in a river course, and characterised by smooth stones made extremely slippery by the action of the water and the clay-rich soil of the area. There were **twelve zones** to be covered over **two laps**, divided into **two blocks of six**.

On Saturday, as far as the Queen TrialGP Class is concerned, it is worth mentioning first of all the great return of **Matteo Grattarola** who, after only a week since the announcement of his return to Beta, and an equally short period of adaptation to the bike, immediately scored a **fourth position** thanks in particular to an excellent second lap, which allowed him to climb

the rankings after some mistakes on the first lap, probably the result of high rider tension and which had penalised him a little. **Aniol Gelabert**, also the author of a good race, finished **sixth**.

In **Trial2 Harry Hemingway** finished **sixth**, showing that he is making the most of his adaptation period in the new category, and starting to put his efforts into action. In **Trial3 George Hemingway** won the day's racing, retaining the **championship lead**. Sixth place for **Jonas Jorgensen**, seventh for **Romeo Piquet** and eighth for **Mirko Pedretti**.

On Sunday the emotions were not lacking, the improving weather allowed the race to run regularly, after the bad weather of the night had made some areas almost impracticable due to the flooding of the river, requiring the marshals to review three areas out of twelve. **Matteo Grattarola**, who was second throughout the first lap, finally finished **third** after a good battle with his rivals, making his return to the team a success. **Aniol Gelabert** was also the author of a beautiful race, and took **fifth** position, fighting with great energy and defending himself adequately from the attacks of his rivals.

In **Trial2 Harry Hemingway** finished in **ninth** place, while in **Trial3 George Hemingway** also **won** this race, consolidating his **first position** in the Overall Classification. Also of note in **Trial3** were the performances of **Romeo Piquet**, author of an excellent race and **third** in the standings, **Mirko Pedretti** **seventh** and **Jonas Jorgensen** **eighth**.

Next appointment with the Trial World Championship in a week's time at **Andorra**.
